<p><u>Monday</u> 1.15–3.15 Stay & Play</p>	<p>A group for children aged 0-5 with ideas and activities for parents and carers to help with general development. Session includes a healthy snack and ends with a singing and story session.</p>
<p><u>Wednesday</u> 1-2.30 Health Visitor Drop in</p>	<p>An opportunity to talk to the Health Visiting Team about your child's health and development and also get your baby weighed. There are occasional workshops such as weaning your baby and new parents groups.</p>
<p><u>Friday</u> 9-11.30 Play & Learn</p>	<p>A group for children aged 0-5 with ideas and activities for parents and carers to help with general development. Session includes a healthy snack and ends with a singing and story session.</p>
<p><u>Friday</u> 1.15-3pm Baby Play & Learn</p>	<p>Based on the PEEP Early Learning Programme. An interactive session for expectant parents or with babies under a year with development activities, information, support and a chance to meet other local parents. £3 per family, £1 concessions to cover resources and materials</p>
<p><u>First Saturday Monthly</u> 10-12 Saturdads</p>	<p>A group for dads and male carers to meet and support their children's learning with appropriate activities. Suitable for children aged 0-6. This session includes a healthy snack</p>
<p>Holiday Programmes</p>	<p>Holiday programmes will be advertised prior to school holidays and are usually suitable for children aged 0 -10 years</p>

All sessions are £2 per family or 50p concessions (except for the Health Visitor Drop in Service which is free and Baby Play & Learn – see above).
